# County Show Work Days



# **Clipping Dates**



Clippers will be available for your use at the high school on the following dates:



Tues. Jan 3<sup>rd</sup> – All Swine



\*If you are in need of another day to clip, please call the office as soon as possible so we can make other arrangements for you.

Your animal must be washed and dried before you bring it to the high school. Dirty animals will not be clipped. There will not be facilities available at the high school for washing your animal(s). Also, you may only bring the animal specified for that particular day. You will need to clean up after you clip your animal. Clippers will not be available to check out January  $2^{nd} - 6^{h}$ , as they will be in use by the agents.

Please call the Extension Office by **December 30<sup>th</sup>**, to reserve a time to clip your animal so we will not have too many animals at the high school at one time.
