Key Points:

- For all Market Lambs, Market Goats, Breeding Sheep, Wether Dams, Breeding Goats, and Wether Does
- Market animals are validated per family
- Breeding Sheep and Goats are validated per exhibitor
 - Wether Dams and Does must comply with breeding animal requirements
- NEW!! San Antonio has changed the name of the Wether Dam and Wether Doe show to Commercial Dam and Commercial Doe
 - o Tagging rules and requirements remain the same
- Heifers still eligible to show for a 2nd year do NOT need to be re-validated if the breed and owner have remained the same
- Lambs & Goats can be county validated for an additional \$15.00/head (cash or check made payable to "ECLA") at this time
- A 2020 2021 Ethics Code form is required for each exhibitor

LAMBS AND GOATS VALIDATED FOR THE 2020 STATE FAIR OF TEXAS WILL HAVE TO BE RE-VALIDATED FOR THE 2021 SPRING/WINTER MAJOR SHOWS.

Texas Lamb Breeders Association (TLBA) tag numbers MUST be in the lamb's ear and be recorded on the validation form at validation and be on the form at the time they are submitted. NO TLBA tag numbers will be added to the validation forms after the forms are submitted to the Sheep and Goat Validation of Texas program. Market lambs must have a GREEN TLBA tag to be eligible to compete in the San Angelo Stock Show or receive TLBA recognition at other major shows. We ther dams must have a BLUE TLBA ewe lamb tag to be eligible to compete in the San Angelo Wether Dam Show.

VALIDATION IS NOT AN ENTRY

COVID - 19 Precautions

Following State and Texas A&M AgriLife recommendations, we highly encourage everyone to keep in mind and practice social distancing while at validation. Please, do not get out of your vehicle until your animals are in the chute/on the stand to limit the number of people congregating around the validation committee. Hand sanitizer and a sink will be available on site, but you will need to bring your own PPE if so desired.



If you are entering the 3rd, 6th, or 9th grade this fall or you are new to 4-H, you must take (or re-take) the Quality Counts course to show your livestock project!! This course must be completed by the <u>Entry Deadline</u> of the show you are planning to attend.

2020 - 2021 Pasture to Packer Program

Interested in what it takes to take a beef steer from the pasture to the packer? Looking to try your hand at a local business venture? Curious how current profit/loss models look in the agriculture industry?

The 9th Annual Erath County Pasture to Packer Program will begin soon! In an effort to educate youth about the production and industry of beef cattle, Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service in Erath County has developed this program. Pasture to Packer encourages youth to become more involved in commercial production and educate them on what is required to get beef cattle from the pasture, to the packer, and finally, to the consumer!

Things participants will learn and do:

- Select and feed out a 750 800 lb steer for 150 – 170 days
- Chute side manners
- Livestock identification
- Complete a loan application for steer
- Marketing tools
- Profit/loss and Revenue models
- Recordkeeping
- Awards Banquet

CLUB MEETINGS

Contact your Club Managers to confirm date, time & location of your next club meeting.

As of July 30, 2020, we are in Phase 3 of Texas A&M AgriLife Extension's "Transitioning Back" guidance.

- Group meetings of 25% capacity of space or fewer people only if social distancing can be practiced with a limited capacity of 50 people. If greater than 50, a preparedness plan must be submitted and approved
