
- <u>Arrive by 12:45pm to register.</u> We will start promptly at 1:00.

- Top two Junior, top two Intermediate, and top two Senior teams will advance to the District 8 Contest

- Teams need to come prepared with their kit and apron (optional)
- Registration costs \$20.00 per team
- Erath 4-H will pay for District registration costs for qualifying teams
- Teams are encouraged during the months of October and November to study and cook at home to gain more practice and confidence

## **Team Presentation Specifics:**

 All team members will have to have some sort of a speaking role

 Timeline – 5 minutes for the presentation; 3 minutes for judges' questions; 4 minutes between team presentation for judges to score and write comments

 Teams may use note cards during presentation, but should not read from them – just use them as guidelines or prompts
