- 1. 8th Graders and anyone in High School at the time of Applying.
- 2. Complete the ambassador application, detailed answers please.
- 3. Applicants will present a 5-minute speech on "What I have done in 2023-2024 to better my community through the 4-H program"

If selected, requirements to remain a county ambassador:

- 1. Help and attend the Erath County 4-H End of Year Banquet, in May.
- 2. Help and attend the Erath County 4-H Kick Off Night in August.
- 3. Help and attend 4-H Cowboy Classic Jackpot Show in November.
- 4. Help with county 4-H contests throughout the year.
- 5. Write a scholarly article for the newsletter.
- 6. Design and implement one community service project.
- 7. Promote county ambassador program to local clubs.
- 8. Participate in TWO district or state 4-H contests, one will be public speaking at the D8 Roundup, you may substitute another heavily speaking oriented contest with 4-H Agents approval prior to the event. (photography does not count towards your 2).
- 9. County 4-H Functions, deemed necessary by Extension office.
- 10. Other items deemed necessary by the ambassador group.
- 11.Re-apply and interview every year.

The role of the Erath Co. 4-H Ambassador is to be that, an Ambassador for the 4-H program, to promote, recruit and educate others on Erath County 4-H. It is not a way to put a check beside all of the boxes to try to get a scholarship.

This role is highly focused on public speaking and is at times a daunting role. You need to be prepared that being a 4-H Ambassador is a lot like having a JOB and the 4-H Agent is your boss. It is a lot of work and is not to be taken lightly.

This is not something you sign-up for a resume or college scholarship application, you become a 4-H Ambassador because you are initiative-taking to making this program the best it can be.
