

- <u>Arrive by 12:45pm to register.</u> We will start promptly at 1:00.
- Parents will be more comfortable leaving and coming back for awards – about 3:30-3:45. No parents are allowed in classroom
- Top two Junior, top two Intermediate, and top two Senior teams will advance to the District 8 Contest
 - o Wednesday, December 3, 2020
 - Bell County Expo Center, Belton, TX
- Teams need to come prepared with their kit and apron (optional)
- Registration costs FREE
- Erath 4-H will pay for District registration costs for qualifying teams
- Teams are encouraged during the months of October and November to study and cook at home to gain more practice and confidence

Team Presentation Specifics:

 All team members will have to have some sort of a speaking role

 Timeline – 5 minutes for the presentation; 3 minutes for judges' questions; 4 minutes between team presentation for judges to score and write comments

 Teams may use note cards during presentation, but should not read from them – just use them as guidelines or prompts

Team Presentation Specifics (cont.):

- Judges may ask questions not directly related to the dish prepared. Some questions may address general knowledge gained through the 4-H members' food and nutrition project learning experiences.
- Parts of the judged presentation include knowledge of MyPlate, nutrient knowledge, food preparation and safety, menu planning, food appearance, and presentation skills
