

All horses shown at the District or State 4-H Horse show MUST BE VALIDATED online through 4-H Connect. Re-validation is required every year for

returning horses/exhibitors.

Cost of Validation per Horse: March 1<sup>st</sup> – April 15<sup>th</sup>: \$10.00 April 16<sup>th</sup> – May 1<sup>st</sup>: \$20.00 May 2<sup>nd</sup> – May 5<sup>th</sup>: \$250.00
