Intensive, Unbiased, Current Instruction

Thank you for expressing an interest in the Master Gardener Program. Attached is the registration information for the 2023 class. During this class, you will receive the most current information from top-notch Extension Specialist, County Extension Agents, and Horticultural Professionals. If you are interested in horticulture, landscaping, or gardening, this is the training for you. The first class will be held on Feb. 2nd from 8:00 am - 1:00 pm with a work through lunch. (Brown bag lunch), at the Texas A&M AgriLife Research Extension (1229 N. US Hwy 281, Stephenville, TX). Subsequent classes will meet every Thursday through mid-April 2023 from 9:00 am - 1:00pm.

Any interested Erath County resident can register. There is a \$175 training fee which will include the Master Gardener Manual, all classroom instruction, volunteer screening and refreshments.

Each participant is required to complete 50 hours of instruction and complete 50 hours of community service through the Extension Office to become a Master Gardener.
